Transfer & Refund Policy: A \$10 fee will be applied to all transfers. To qualify for a refund, you must cancel no later than one week prior to the start of the camp week. A refund minus \$25 per refunded week will be given for all cancellations made before the deadline. No refunds will be given after this deadline.

Registration Information:

Town of Palm Beach Resident Registration: Begins **Monday, March 3rd @8:00am** (proof of Town residency is required) and may be done directly through the DaySmart portal (palmbeachrecreation.com), or by calling the office at 561-838-5485.

Nonresident Registration: Nonresidents may also register through the DaySmart portal (palmbeachrecreation.com), with registration opening on **Monday, March 24th @8:00am.**

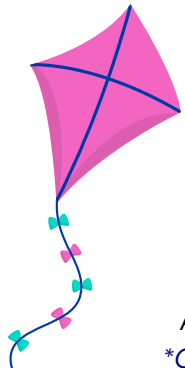

Payment in full must be made upon registration for camp sessions your child is attending.

Early and extended care packages can be added on at any time during the camp season.

Appropriate forms will be required before your child can begin camp, they are listed below:

Proof of Residency (required for resident validation): Tax Bill, Drivers License/State issued ID Card, Voter Registration, Utility Bill, Credit Card/Bank Mail, Unexpired Town Employee I.D., Retired Employee (verified by HR), Deed showing TOPB Property Ownership, Lease or Purchase agreement (6 months or more). Items must list individuals name and valid Town of Palm Beach residential address.



IMPORTANT NOTICES:



*A confirmation along with camp details and important forms will be emailed to you upon registration.

***All medications** need an authorization form and must be turned in to the office. Staff will dispense according to directions provided by physician. Campers are not permitted to carry medication in their lunches or camp bags.

***Campers are required to bring a non-perishable lunch daily.** Refrigeration and/or heating is not available.

*Camp Shirts are required on field trip days. Registration includes either one camp shirt and a camp bag or two camp shirts . Extra shirts may be purchased at the front desk.

*Campers should wear light, comfortable clothing, sneakers and socks daily. Review the Camp Connection to ensure your child is dressed appropriately (i.e. sun screen applied, bathing suit (no bikinis allowed), and towel) . Leave all valuables home!

Program Waiver and Release of All Claims:

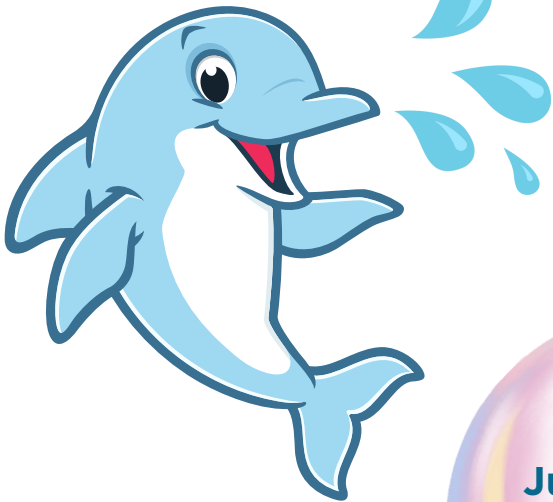
